DORMANCY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

The Massachusetts Abandoned Property Law (M.G.L. c. 200A) requires all financial institutions to review their records to determine if they are in possession of funds that have gone unclaimed and dormant for a three (3) year period or more.

Our records indicate your Primary Share (Savings) Account has been dormant (inactive) for the past three (3) years.

As always, the credit union's goal is to reactivate your account and maximize the value of your membership.

If you believe your account may fall into this category, please follow the steps listed below:

THE SOLUTION IS EASY AND PAINLESS

To remove the dormancy status, perform any one of the following:

1. Make a deposit into your Primary Share (Savings) Account
2. Authorize Direct Deposit from external sources such as payroll or social security
3. Make a withdrawal from your Primary Share (Savings) Account
4. OR, complete, sign and mail us the acknowledgement (at the bottom of this letter) regarding your awareness of the Account.

YOUR RESPONSE IS NEEDED BY OCTOBER 31st. Without it, the credit union will be forced to relinquish your funds and send them to the Massachusetts State Treasurer's Department.
